

## ECHO RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **MANAGEMENT:** The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of or incident to the Show without claims for damage or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in the rules and regulations or class specifications shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, whose decision is final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, to accept conditionally, or to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, and to change rings or judges.
2. **ENTRY AGREEMENT:** Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, coach, rider and the horse 1) shall be subject to the local rules of the show; 2) that every horse and/or rider is eligible as entered; 3) that the owner and any of its representatives are bound by the rules of the show and will accept as final the decision of the show management on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; 4) that the owner, rider and any of their agents or representatives agree to hold the show and its officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts of said officials, show management, employees or volunteers. I agree to indemnify and save harmless the ECHO Horse Show and Pillsbury Land and Livestock Corp., and singular any directors, officers, member employees and agents thereof from and against any and all loss, costs or expenses, or any claim thereof, of whatever nature arising or to arise, for and on account, or by reason of the entry or entries hereby made.
3. **ADDS /SCRATCHES:** Before a class begins, it may be **added** without additional charge **or scratched** with full refund. **After the class begins, no adds are allowed and no refund will be given for scratches.**
4. **NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS:** There will be a penalty of \$25.00 for entries paid by a check that is returned by the bank for any reason.
5. **BILLING:** Any unpaid entries from the show that have to be billed for payment following the show will be subject to an additional \$25 charge unless prior arrangements have been made.
6. **SCHEDULING: Ring 1** begins at 9:15. The first 2 classes of all hunter divisions will run with 2 open cards. Horses will rotate in groups of 4 through both rounds before going to the next group. Please sign up at the gate for a spot in the order before the start of the class. **Ring 2** begins promptly at 8:15 with hunter hack. All entered should be in the ring at 8:15. It is the intention of the management to avoid holding rings to wait for exhibitors or trainers. It is the responsibility of each trainer and exhibitor to keep track of the progress of the show. Although we make every effort to announce reasonable calls for classes, announcements can not always be heard in all areas of the parking lot. We apologize for any inconvenience. There will be no refunds for missed classes.
7. **MEDAL CLASSES:** All medal classes will run with a drawn order of go which will be posted no less than 15 minutes before the start of the class. Last minute entries will go at the top of the order.
8. **GSDHJA POINTS ASSIGNMENT:** A competitor who wishes to insure proper assignment of GSDHJA points must complete a GSDHJA declaration form. Forms will be available at the entry booth.
9. **DOGS:** Dogs are a serious health and safety issue. Dogs must be leashed and under control at all times. Violators may be asked to leave.
10. **NUMBERS:** Horses are required to have their correct horseshow entry # attached whenever they are exhibiting or warming up.
11. **PARKING:** All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas. Access roads are for ingress and egress only. No vehicles may be parked in the vicinity of the entry booth.
